


## Ulm Fishermen's **Jousting Tournament** 24./31.07.2022



2022 sees the traditional event of the old free imperial city of Ulm making a welcome return: since 1950, the jousting tournament has usually taken place every four years and is organised by the local fishermen's guild. In 1662, the event was linked to Ulm's Oath Day for the first time. According to a local legend, two fishermen from Ulm observed a knights' jousting tournament held by monks from Reichenau Monastery who were resident in Ulm. Both of them thought that they could also do this but, due to the lack of horses, they competed against each other using their boats on the river.



The parade lasts about three hours whereby the dances performed by members of the Ulm fishermen's guild are staged at up to seven locations. These historical processions have also enriched the repertoire of characters seen at the jousting where figures from local tradition have also been represented since 1877 such as the Ulm sparrow and tailor of Ulm.

The jousting event is a real tournament on the water with 15 pairs of jousters who represent characters from history as well as original figures. The actual jousting lasts around 90 minutes and takes place on the Danube in front of the historic backdrop of Ulm's old city district. Large grandstands are erected on the river banks for the spectators.
